

## What is AILA?

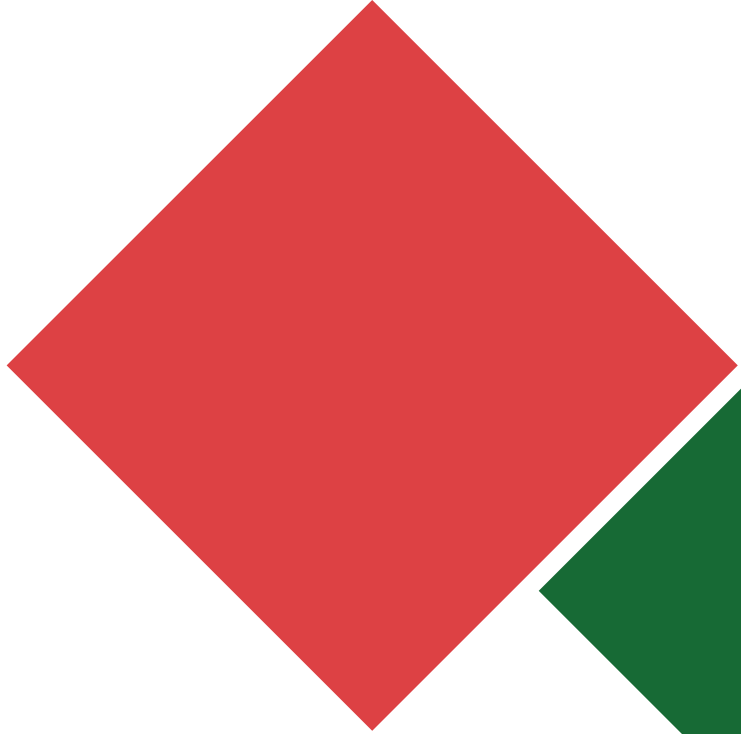
- AILA is a national organisation formed to provide:
  - A forum for the promotion, review, development and debate of insurance law.
  - Insurance law education through seminars, workshops and conferences.
- AILA membership is open to anyone. Current membership includes brokers, adjusters, insurers, reinsurers, academics, regulators and lawyers.
- AILA is the Australian chapter of the International Association for Insurance Law (AIDA). AIDA has more than 60 international chapters.
