Civil Liability legislation – generated by the *Review of the law of negligence: final report, 2002,* authored by a Panel of Eminent Persons chaired by the Honourable David Andrew Ipp AO – has been in place now for some 15 years. Legislation was spawned at a time of upheaval in the insurance industry. Some insurers reduced the extent of the indemnity cover they were prepared to extend to renewing or proposed insureds, or simply refused to offer certain types of cover. The Ipp legislation enacted in the states and territories, along with cognate federal legislation, were directed at balancing the scales in proof of liability and moderating the assessment of damages. This paper examines the success of that endeavour by reference to the jurisprudence which has emerged. Did the legislation go too far or not far enough?
