Kevin Holyoak presents 'Are reports of the "death" of Byrne v PRQ greatly exaggerated?: The new section 236B of the Workers' Compensation and Rehabilitation Act 2003'.

Mark Twain famously stated that the reports of his death were greatly exaggerated. Can the same be said of Byrne v PRQ?

Section 236B of the WCRA is directed at a legislative reversal of the decision in Byrne v People Resourcing (Qld) Pty Ltd & Anor. These amendments declare void certain indemnities.

In this breakfast seminar Kevin Holyoak will examine whether the amendments made to the WCRA hit, or miss, their target. Issues which will be addressed include:

- the key steps in the outcome in Byrne v PRQ
- whether the amendments address these steps
- what may be affected by the amendments and what may not be
